CORE, OPTIONS AND ELECTIVES

In completing a degree programme in the Department of Management Studies, students are required to take three types of courses.

- Core
- Option
- Elective

A core is a required course and students cannot substitute any other course for a core course.

An option is a required course from a list of courses provided. Students must select the number of options required for the programme from the list of options provided.

An elective is an approved course that can be selected from within the department or from any other department. In selecting an elective the department requires that **all such courses be at level 2 or 3. No level 1 course can be used as an elective.**
